She has just finished her ministry of 14 years with The Outreach Foundation, an independent Presbyterian mission organization. Prior to that, she was on staff at Peachtree Presbyterian Church in Atlanta where she oversaw the International partnerships of this 8,000-member congregation in over 33 countries. She has led over 100 mission trips and still travels frequently to the Middle East (Egypt, Syria, Lebanon, Iraq and the Holy Land) which is an area of specialty for her. Marilyn holds a B.A. in Classical Studies, and two M.A.s (Art History and Theology). She is an ordained elder, and, when she is not “on the road” overseas, preaches and speaks around the United States. She and her husband of 44 years, Mark, make their home in Savannah.
